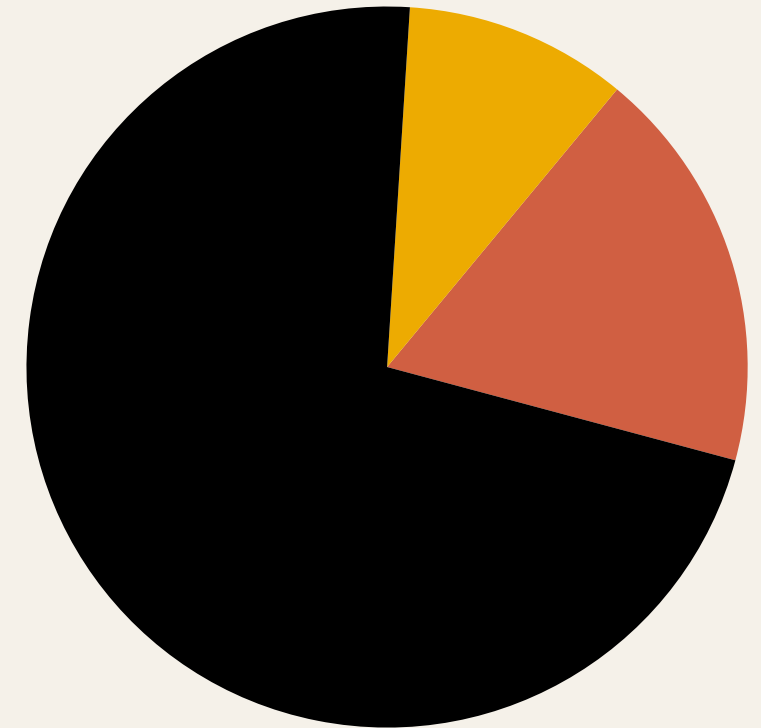

# SHELTER IN DNIPRO: 120 PEOPLE

€21,343

The organization evacuates over 50 people weekly from the front-line territories in the Kharkiv, Donetsk, and Luhansk regions. All displaced people are accommodated in shelters. Approximately 80-100 people reside here monthly, with the majority being permanent residents.

# TWO SHELTERS IN DNIPROPETROVSK REGION: 50 PEOPLE

€2,797

Shelters welcome people who have experienced occupation, lost their homes and/or relatives. In shelters, they are assisted in restoring documents and socially adapting to their new lives.

Shelters need regular help with rent and utility bills, as well as humanitarian aid for residents: food, medicine, and essential items.

# ANIMAL SHELTER IN KHARKIV: FOOD FOR 50 CATS AND DOGS

In the shelter, there are about 400 dogs and 100 cats in total. Here come abandoned and lost animals from the entire Kharkiv region, as well as from the liberated territories. Often, these are animals affected by shelling, which are in a stressful condition, requiring veterinary care and rehabilitation.

# RESTORATION POTEMKIN FAMILY HOUSE IN MYKOLAIV

€5,442

The Potemkin family house in Mykolaiv was hit during shelling in early February. At the time of the strike, Tetiana, her children Oleksander and Iryna, as well as her grandchildren, were inside. The family survived. Several walls of the house were destroyed, the roof was blown off, the ceiling collapsed in one of the rooms, and the gas pipe was damaged.
