EVACUATION OF ELDERLY PEOPLE FROM OCCUPIED AND FRONTLINE TERRITORIES

Every month, volunteers help evacuate elderly people with limited mobility from occupied territories. This is not an easy task, as organizing the evacuation requires not only logistical planning but also finding people to help push wheelchairs and provide for the elderly throughout the journey

For the second consecutive month, thanks to "Let's help" campaign, volunteers have been able to evacuate up to 10 people per month from settlements in occupied territories (sometimes from hard-to-reach and constantly shelled villages).

The costs include: payment for medical transportation, train tickets, the work of caregivers, the salary of the curator of the mobility assistance program, accommodation, commissions and taxes, wheelchairs, food, communication, and medicines.

SHELTER IN DNIPRO: 120 PEOPLE

For the third month now, we have been helping a shelter in Dnipro, which houses more than 120 people. This month, we again transferred funds to pay for utilities and food purchases. For another month, people can feel safe.

The shelter in Dnipro is our regular partner, assisting us in other projects, such as delivering generators to Ukraine.



WHO SHELTERS IN THE DNIPROPETROVSK REGION

Shelters in the Dnipropetrovsk region are also our regular partners. We help not only with purchasing food and paying for utilities but also support them when they need to carry out repairs.

Thanks to your help, we managed to repair pipes and the boiler so that the residents of the shelter have hot water and heat. Moreover, Easter at the shelter was celebrated properly.



HUMANITARIAN AID FOR 360 PEOPLE

RENT FEE FOR A MEAL PREPARATION SPACE FOR THOSE AFFECTED BY SHELLING, RESCUERS, AND VOLUNTEERS

The charitable organization prepares over 700 meals daily in Kharkiv. With your help, we are able to pay for rent and utilities so that volunteers and staff can continue preparing meals. In May, the staff went out with meals to the sites of attacks and fed the rescuers.



FAMILY FROM ODESA **£503**

On March 2, a Russian drone destroyed a residential multi-story building in Odesa. Tetiana and her son survived, but their apartment is completely destroyed. We have already helped the family by purchasing essential items and remain in contact to provide further assistance.
