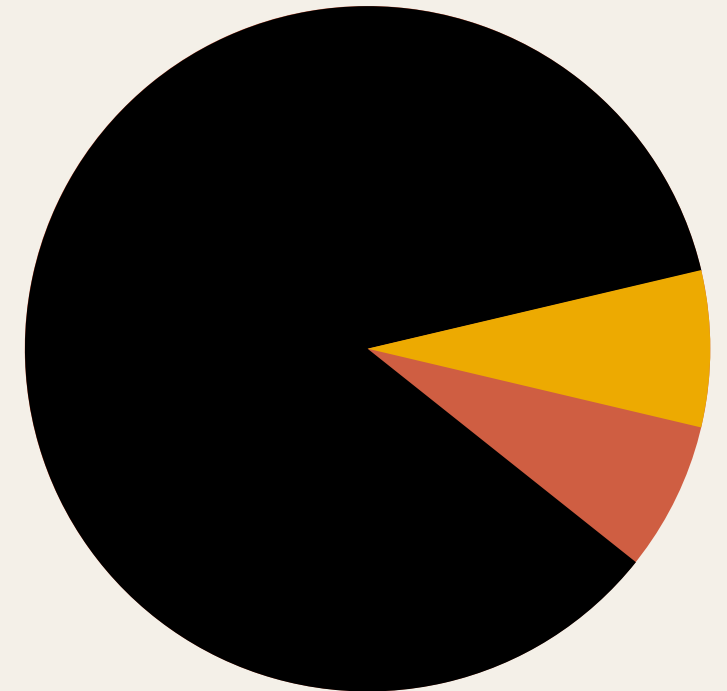

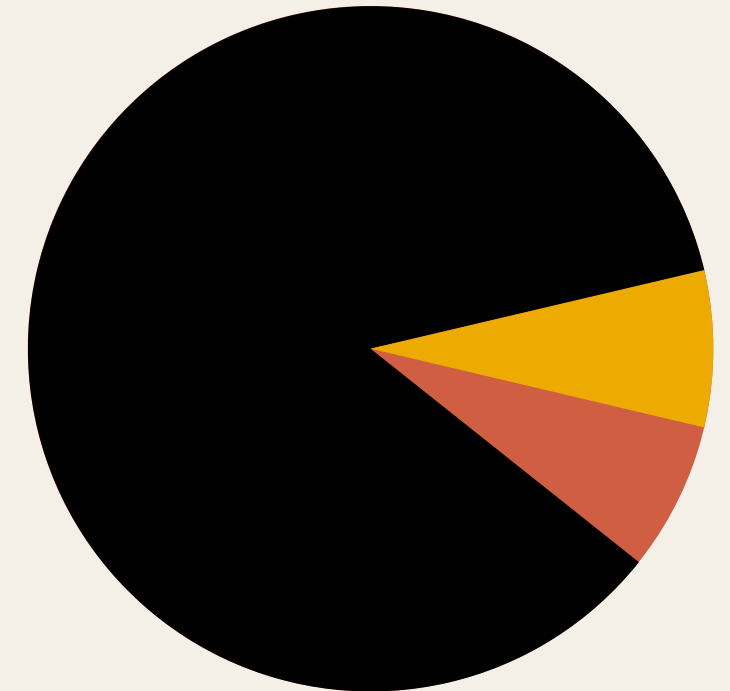

EVACUATION OF PEOPLE WITH LIMITED MOBILITY FROM FRONTLINE TERRITORIES **€4,000**

Our new partners are a team that, since the beginning of the full-scale war, has been evacuating people with limited mobility, people with disabilities, and their families from frontline territories. During the full-scale war, they managed to evacuate and place more than 5,500 people. They help both with moving within Ukraine and with leaving for Europe.

The partners also have a shelter near Kyiv, where evacuated people can live temporarily, receive basic help, and recover after what they have experienced.

Thanks to your donations, we can support the work of such teams and help people who cannot evacuate on their own.

EMERGENCY AID IN DNIPRO

€6,000

Our Dnipro partners continue to go to the sites of strikes in Dnipro and the surrounding region. In April, the group made seven such trips.

The team repaired approximately 215 broken windows. During these trips, they distributed more than 825 hot drinks and snacks, provided psychological support to 45 people, and distributed warm blankets and clothing to affected families.

In April, our partners also placed four people in a shelter in Pridniprovsk, providing them with temporary safe housing and basic living conditions.

Thanks to your donations, our partners maintain a stock of basic materials and products to react as quickly as possible to new strikes and support people in their darkest moments.

SUPPORT FOR SHELTERS IN DNIPRO €4,000

Yaroslava evacuated from the village of Ukrainske with her two children and young granddaughter. In recent months, the frontline moved closer to the village, "Shahed" drone strikes became more frequent, and local authorities began discussing mandatory evacuation for families with children. When the situation became too dangerous, Yaroslava asked our partners for help. Now the family is in a shelter for mothers and children.

In April, our partners — the **CHILDREN NEW GENERATION** foundation — continued to support people forced to flee their homes. Currently, 62 people live permanently in the organization's main shelter, and the shelter for mothers and children took in 55 people this month. Here, people find safe temporary housing, a chance to recover, and necessary support. Your donations help keep these shelters running: paying utility bills, purchasing household goods and essentials, and maintaining safe conditions.

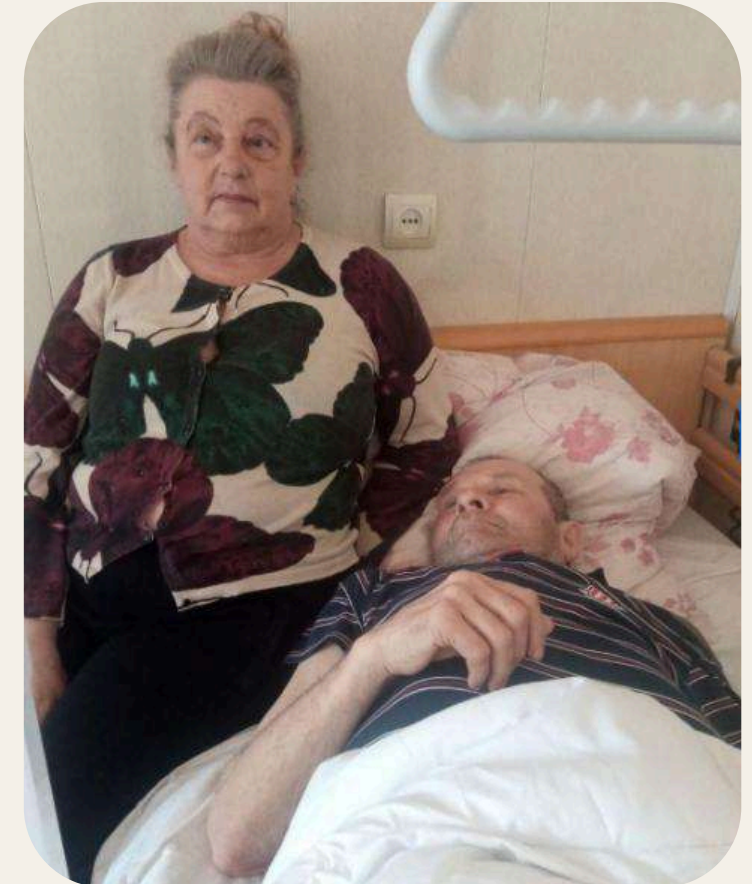

HELP TO A SHELTER FOR PEOPLE WITH LIMITED MOBILITY €4,003

Serhii and Olha lived in the village of Tymofiivka, Kharkiv region, in their own house and kept a farm. A few weeks ago, Serhii had a stroke — he lost consciousness right in the yard on the way to the barn. Olha called an ambulance, but because of a "Shahed" attack, the medics could not reach them. Later, the military contacted the family and informed them that they would evacuate them. During the evacuation, Olha only managed to take her husband's documents — her own documents and medicines remained at home.

After three weeks of treatment in the hospital, the couple was brought to the shelter. Now a case manager is helping Olha restore her documents and find housing for the family.

Our partners support people with special needs who were forced to leave dangerous regions. The team helps organize the evacuation, accompanies families during the move, places them in a shelter, and helps find more stable living conditions. Thanks to your support, 23 people received such help in April.

DELIVERY OF HOT FOOD TO PEOPLE AFFECTED BY SHELLING **€6,000**

Our Kharkiv partners — the "**ROKSANA AND TEAM**" foundation — continued to feed residents of Kharkiv and neighboring regions affected by the war in April. Over the month, they prepared and delivered:

- 7,000 hot meals to a shelter for people with limited mobility;
- 5,000 hot meals, 15,000 sandwiches, drinks, and sweets to evacuation centers in Kharkiv;
- 5,000 sandwiches and sweets to an evacuation center in the Kharkiv region;
- 3,000 cottage cheese Easter cakes for the holiday for internal refugees and Kharkiv residents;
- 1,200 hot meals and sweets for children with and without disabilities evacuated from the Donetsk region, and much more.

In addition, there were 44 strikes in Kharkiv in April, to three of which our partners went personally, and for the others, they delivered hot meals, drinks, sweets, and sandwiches for the victims, rescuers, and volunteers. You and I ensure the stable operation of the foundation: with your donations, the team purchases food and disposable tableware every month, and also pays for the rent of the premises for cooking.

HELP TO A SHELTER IN THE DNIPROPETROVSK REGION

€7,430

Anna and Oleksandr are originally from Kostiantynivka, Donetsk region. After the war began, the family hid from shelling in a cellar and hesitated to leave for a long time. But in November 2023, they were caught in shelling and were heavily wounded. Soldiers ran to their cries for help, provided first aid, and evacuated them first to a hospital in Kramatorsk and then to Dnipro. Unfortunately, the consequences of the shelling for both are severe: concussion, multiple shrapnel wounds, and leg amputations. Now the family lives in our partners' shelter "**MOTIVATION TO LIVE**," where they are helped to restore documents, get prosthetics, and recover their psychological state. In April, your donations provided the shelter residents with a roof over their heads, food, and care, and also allowed the team to:

- widen the doorway in the shelter, install a new entrance door, and remove the threshold — now it is more comfortable for people in wheelchairs to enter and leave the house;
- manufacture and install special handrails for bathrooms for people with disabilities;
- take the shelter residents for a full check-up at a hospital in Dnipro;
- conduct workshops for Easter and celebrate the holiday.

HELP TO A SHELTER FOR IDPS AND MOTHERS WITH CHILDREN IN KAMIANSKE €1,860

Kateryna is originally from the village of Novoselivka, Donetsk region, which has been temporarily occupied since 2024. In the fall of 2023, due to the proximity to the front, the girl was forced to leave. Now Kateryna lives in our partners' shelter in the city of Kamianske, Dnipropetrovsk region. Here they help her improve her health (the girl has anemia and thyroid problems) and not lose heart.

The shelter accepts a wide variety of people who have lost their homes because of the war. About 40 people live here permanently, and a few more find refuge for a time. Unfortunately, the team has very few resources, and without our help, they have no way to cover even the most basic needs. In April, we purchased food for the shelter for the next month. We also paid for the replacement of an old chimney and the installation of new screens on the windows.

MEDICATIONS, VACCINES, AND DOG FOOD FOR A SHELTER IN KHARKIV

€3,480

The photo shows fox cubs (yes, fox cubs!) that were abandoned in a box at the gates of a Kharkiv enterprise. The employees of the enterprise did not lose their heads and turned to our regular partners for help — the **KHARKIV CITY PET SHELTER**. Although the shelter does not deal with wild animals, they could not refuse and took the animals. The shelter's doctors examined and vaccinated the cubs and then handed them over to a public organization that specializes in helping wild animals.

In April, the Kharkiv shelter took in 141 dogs and 44 cats. Veterinarians sterilized 155 animals, and 65 dogs and cats found a new home or came under the care of public organizations. Now the shelter cares for 481 animals. Your donations provided veterinary drugs, vaccines, and food for them.

FOOD, CAT LITTER, AND RENT FOR A SHELTER FOR EVACUATED PETS

€3,650

The cat in the photo is named Lapchik. He was evacuated from Bohodukhiv, Kharkiv region — for a long time, he would not approach people, he was afraid. The boy has advanced osteochondrodysplasia (sick paws, genetic mutation). Our partners — the **ANIMAL GUARDIANS** organization — have already taken Lapchik to the clinic, where he was neutered, his paws were treated, and tests were done. Unfortunately, he was diagnosed with Feline Immunodeficiency Virus, but he is undergoing therapy to live a long and happy life. 140 cats and 13 dogs live in the organization's shelter. Thanks to you, in April the team was able to:

- purchase food, cat litter, and household supplies;
- pay for the rent of the premises, utility services, and the work of the employee who cares for the animals;
- purchase medicines and pay for the treatment of the pets.

EMERGENCY AID IN KRYVVI RIH €700

In April, we continued working with a rapid response group from Kryvyi Rih. It consists of several dozen people who support local residents in the first hours after Russian attacks. Volunteers clear rubble, fix broken windows and doors, and prepare housing for repair work. In addition, the young people care for the victims: for this, the team underwent first aid training. With your donations, in April we managed to purchase fuel for the work car so that the group's work could continue. We also opened a separate collection to promptly support the team:

TREATMENT OF A DRIVER AFTER BEING WOUNDED €2,046

A driver who was helping to evacuate people from the combat zone came under fire and received severe injuries to both legs. He has already had two operations, with long-term treatment and recovery ahead.

Thanks to the reserve funds of the "Let's Help" project, we were able to quickly pay for part of the treatment and rehabilitation of the driver, who continued to save others even in the most dangerous conditions.

KATERYNA IVANIVNA FROM KHARKIV

€2,323

On March 26, 2025, a Russian drone flew into the yard of Kateryna Ivanivna's house in Kharkiv. The woman received light injuries, and her shepherd dog Emir's lip was torn. The house they lived in was destroyed. The woman could not move to a shelter or a dormitory because she did not want to give her dog to a shelter, so in May of that year, we opened a collection to help Kateryna Ivanivna repair the house and continue living there with her dog.

While we were collecting money, Kateryna Ivanivna received approval for her application under the state housing restoration program. As a result, over this year, she managed to fix the roof, replace the windows, and repair part of the walls and ceiling, and we stayed in touch with her all this time. In April, we sent Kateryna Ivanivna the collected money so that she could continue the repairs: the woman still needs to repair the floor, finish the ceiling, and complete the restoration.



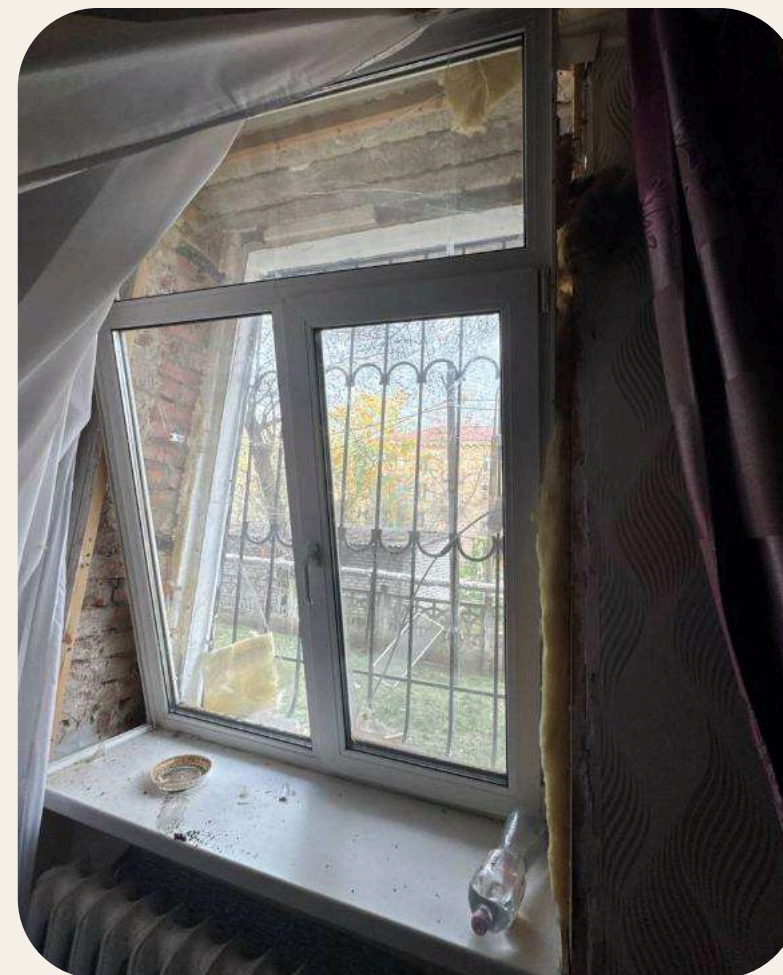

TETIANA'S FAMILY FROM DNIPRO €430

Tetiana and her parents are residents of Dnipro, whose apartment was damaged during the shelling of the city on the night of April 25. All the windows in the apartment were blown out and the door was torn out, and it is temporarily impossible to live in the building: the neighboring entrance was destroyed, and there is no gas, light, or water in the house.

While the decision on the possible restoration of the house is being made and construction work is being planned, Tetiana and her parents moved to other housing, installed new windows themselves, and we sent them money to replace the entrance door so that the family would not worry about the theft of personal belongings.

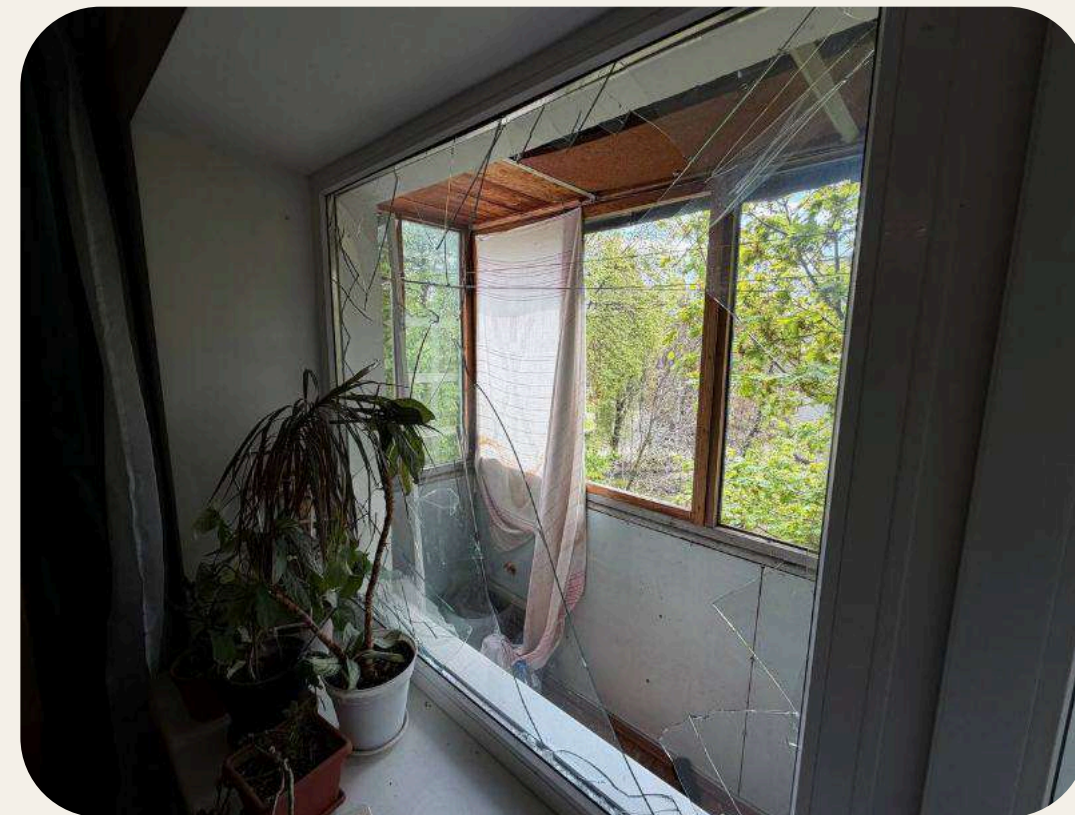

SERHII FROM DNIPRO **€350**

Serhii's apartment was also damaged by the shelling of Dnipro on the night of April 25 — Serhii and Tetiana, whom we wrote about on the previous page, live in neighboring houses. His balcony unit was damaged: it took the main hit, almost all the glass in the window frames flew out, and shrapnel "pierced" through the facade of the balcony and even the wardrobe in the bedroom. Serhii temporarily covered the broken windows with film received from volunteers and closed them with OSB boards, as he remained living in this apartment.

We sent Serhii money to replace the necessary windows.

The funds just arrived. I'm already checking for window installers. Thank you very much once again 🙏



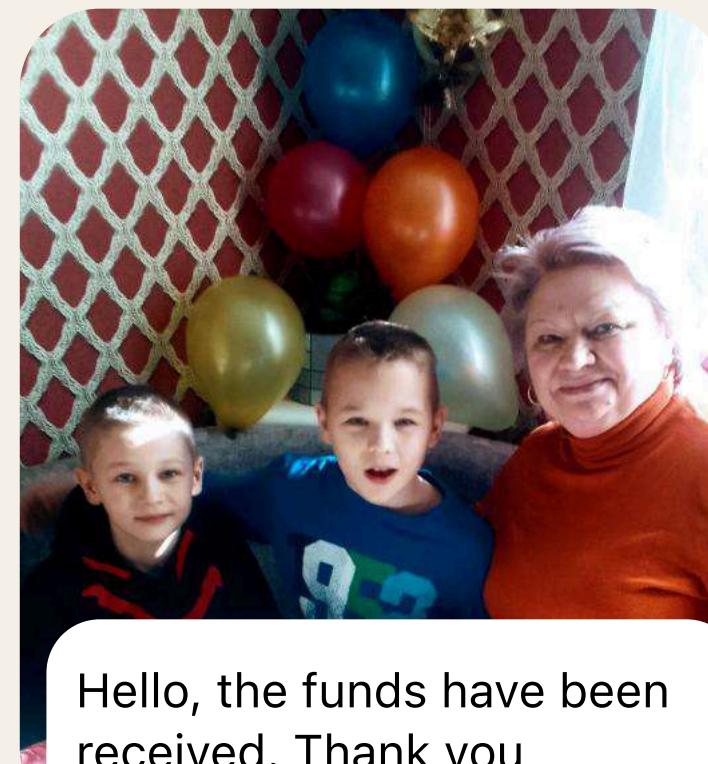
ALLA FROM THE POLTAVA REGION

€1,000

61-year-old Alla lived in the Mezhyvska community of the Dnipropetrovsk region and worked as an occupational safety engineer in a local hospital. In September 2023, as a result of shelling by Russian aviation bombs, this hospital was destroyed, and the woman's work was suspended.

Alla moved to the Poltava region, where she now rents housing. The woman lives on her pension and IDP payments, but this is not enough for living and regularly purchasing medicine — Alla has a number of chronic diseases. Alla's only son is currently forced to remain in the frontline territory and cannot financially support his mother.

We sent Alla money to buy a new refrigerator to replace the broken one, a mattress, food, and medicine, so that the woman could slightly improve her everyday life and get her life back on track.

TETIANA'S FAMILY FROM KRYVVI RIH

€1,500

Tetiana lives in Kryvyi Rih, works in a store, and is raising a school-aged son alone.

Her husband joined the AFU at the beginning of the full-scale war, and in 2023, he did not return from service. On March 31, a Russian drone destroyed Tetiana's house: that day, the Dnipropetrovsk region was attacked more than 40 times. The woman and her son were home during the shelling — fortunately, they were not injured, but the family no longer has a home.

We transferred funds to them for renting new housing and purchasing items necessary for the first few months.

EVACUATION OF PEOPLE FROM OCCUPIED TERRITORIES

€1,500

Mykhailo, Kateryna (names changed), and their dog lived in the temporarily occupied part of the Kherson region. Their granddaughter is a Ukrainian journalist and activist, and her husband is a current member of the AFU. Mykhailo and Kateryna were repeatedly visited by security forces who exerted pressure on them. They also suffered from a strike and underwent six months of rehabilitation before our partners were able to take them out.

Our partner organization evacuates people from the temporarily occupied territories of Ukraine — after evacuation, they are sent to areas controlled by Ukraine or to the EU. In April, your donations helped save 5 people and 1 dog from the occupied territories: they covered transport, preparation of documents for departure, the team's work, food, and medicine for the evacuees.
